The IZard County Consolidated School Board met in regular session on August 15, 2019, in the IZard County High School Board Room.

Roll call showed all members present.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Danny Blankenship, to approve the minutes of the July 8, 2019, regular meeting. Motion passed, 7-0.

Debbie Moody made a motion, seconded by Candace Killian, to approve the financial report. Motion passed, 7-0.

Superintendent Fred Walker told the board that the school district has an enrollment of 528, up 24 students from last year.

Principal Billy McBride announced that the school show team had participated recently in the IZard, Fulton, and Sharp County Livestock Shows and the students had won numerous awards in the horse, sheep, goat, hog, and cattle shows. McBride also noted that Cross Country Coach Jared Humphrey has 18 students participating in cross country this year and they will compete in nine cross country events plus the state championship meet in Hot Springs. McBride also announced that 2019 ICC graduates Hayden Ekenes and Caleb Rushing had been awarded North Arkansas Electric Cooperative Round-up Scholarships recently. School administrators told the board that the recent Open House had a great turnout by parents/guardians and students.

Debbie Moody made a motion, seconded by Candace Killian, to transfer \$100,000 from the operating fund to the building fund. Motion passed, 7-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Debbie Moody, to accept the bids from SOPA, Inc. for elementary playground equipment and an elementary stage curtain and a bid from Hill's Auto Sales for a 2015 Chevy Colorado pickup. Motion passed, 7-0.

Candace Killian made a motion, seconded by Danny Blankenship, to approve school transfers. Motion passed 7-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Candace Killian, to adjourn at 7:30 p.m. Motion passed, 7-0.
