The IZARD County Consolidated School Board met in regular session on August 20, 2018, in the IZARD County High School Board Room.

Roll call showed all members present.

Rhonda Moss made a motion, seconded by Debbie Moody, to approve the minutes of the July 16, 2018, regular meeting. Motion passed, 7-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Danny Blankenship, to approve the financial report. Motion passed, 7-0.

Superintendent Fred Walker discussed the annual school audit with the board and told the board that preliminary enrollment information shows that the district's enrollment is presently up over 50 students from last year.

Debbie Moody made a motion, seconded by Mike McCandlis, to approve the transfer of \$200,000 from the operating fund to the building fund. Motion passed, 7-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Julia Chapman, to accept the resignations of Special Education Paraprofessional April Glass and High School Teacher Louise McBride. Motion passed, 7-0.

Danny Blankenship made a motion, seconded by Julia Chapman, to accept the banking services bid of FNBC. Motion passed, 7-0. Other bidders were Bancorp South, FNBIC, and the Bank of Salem. Superintendent Walker commented that the district appreciated the good service provided by Bancorp South over the past several years.

Danny Blankenship made a motion, seconded by Rhonda Moss, to approve transfers. Motion passed, 7-0.

Principal Billy McBride told the board that school year had started well and he was proud of the school livestock team and the many awards the students won at the Fulton, Sharp, and IZARD County Fairs recently. McBride said Agri teachers Isaac Blankenship and Jared Johnson were to be commended for their help with the many ICC students competing in the livestock shows.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Julia Chapman, to adjourn at 8:00 p.m. Motion passed, 7-0.
