The IZARD County Consolidated School Board met in regular session on February 12, 2020, in the IZARD County High School Board Room.

Roll call showed Julia Chapman absent.

Michael McBryde with Stephens, Inc .discussed options with the board on financing the proposed track and field project.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Debbie Moody, to approve a resolution authorizing the issuance of second lien bonds in the amount of approximately \$790,000 using Stephens, Inc. Motion passed, 6-0.

Debbie Moody made a motion, seconded by Rhonda Moss, to approve the minutes of the January 20, 2020, regular meeting. Motion passed, 6-0.

Danny Blankenship made a motion, seconded by Candace Killian , to approve the financial report. Motion passed, 6-0.

Robert Reeves made a motion, seconded by Candace Killian, to extend the contracts of 5-12 Principal Billy McBride, Elementary Principal Eve Hatman, Assistant Principal David Harmon, and Assistant Principal Tim Massey by one year through June 30, 2022.

Principal Billy McBride announced that the junior high chess team won the coop chess tournament recently and also won several individual awards. Keegan Johnson, Zander McCandlis, Chris Densford, and Jacob Stone placed first, second, fourth, and fifth, respectively, in the junior high division and Chris Burris and Denton Reiley were second and sixth, respectively, in the senior high division.
