The IZARD County Consolidated School Board met in regular session on January 11, 2017, in the IZARD County High School Board Room.

Roll call showed all members present.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Danny Blankenship to approve the minutes of the December 12, 2016, regular meeting. Motion passed, 7-0.

Danny Blankenship made a motion, seconded by Debbie Moody, to approve the financial report. Motion passed, 7-0.

Superintendent Fred Walker announced that the district had been awarded \$22,100 through the Arkansas School Recognition Program of the Arkansas Department of Education. Walker said the middle school was awarded \$14,800 for high student academic growth and the high school was awarded \$7,300 for high academic growth and a high graduation rate.

High School Principal David Harmon announced that the high school shooting sports team had been awarded a \$2000 grant by the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission for a new trap machine. The grant was written by Shooting Sports Coach Wayne Neal.

Middle School Principal Billy McBride announced that the district had been approved by the Arkansas Department of Education and the Arkansas Public School Resource Center to receive three virtual reality kits for use by students and teachers in middle school, high school, and the EAST program.

High School Principal Harmon commended the boys and girls senior high basketball teams for reaching the final four of the Northeast Arkansas Invitational Tournament and announced that Sam King, Jen King, Taylor Reynolds, and Justus Cooper were named to the All-Tournament Team.

Debbie Moody made a motion, seconded by Rhonda Moss, to extend Superintendent Fred Walker's contract by one year through June 30, 2020. Motion passed, 7-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Rhonda Moss, to adjourn at 8:19 p.m. Motion passed, 7-0.
