The IZARD County Consolidated School Board met in regular session on July 11, 2016, in the IZARD County High School Board Room.

Roll call showed Rhonda Moss absent.

Danny Blankenship made a motion, seconded by Julia Chapman, to approve the minutes of the June 20, 2016 regular meeting. Motion passed, 6-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Danny Blankenship, to approve the financial report. Motion passed, 6-0.

Mike McCandlis left the meeting at this time.

Danny Blankenship made a motion, seconded by Debbie Moody, to continue to do business with Reeves Propane, Inc., (Board member Robert Reeves is owner) Knockout, Inc. (Board member Mike McCandlis is owner), and the Pacesetter Times (Maintenance worker Randy Sherrell is the husband of owner) because they are located in the school district and offer competitive prices. Motion passed, 5-0.

Julia Chapman made a motion, seconded by Candace Killian, to accept the following annual bids: Sanitation – Waste Connections, Milk – Kallsnick, Inc., and Pest Control – Knockout, Inc. Motion passed, 5-0.

Mike McCandlis returned to the meeting at this time.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Julia Chapman, to accept the annual propane bid from IZARD County Propane. Motion passed, 5-1.

Debbie Moody made a motion, seconded by Candace Killian, to employ Brittany Shrable as an elementary cook for the 2016-17 school year. Motion passed, 6-0.

Robert Reeves made a motion, seconded by Mike McCandlis, to approve the bids: paving work at the middle/high school from Trico, Inc. and resealing work at the elementary school from Johnson's Sealcoating and Striping. Motion passed, 6-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Danny Blankenship, to appoint Candace Killian to the vacant vice-president position on the school board. Motion passed, 6-0.

Julia Chapman made a motion, seconded by Danny Blankenship, to approve transfers. Motion passed, 6-0.

Superintendent Fred Walker commended the Arkansas Department of Corrections North Central Unit inmate crew for their help in sprucing up the elementary campus recently. The crew helped with a landscape project and general maintenance at the elementary school. Walker noted that the inmate crew has been of invaluable help for the district over the years.

Walker also told the board that high school teacher Rachel Faulkner had just completed a two week inservice in Rolla, Missouri, so the high school could add a third course, Medical Interventions, to its Biomedical Sciences Program. Ms. Faulkner holds a master's degree in biology and also teaches Principles of Biological Sciences and Human Body Systems in the program.

High School Principal David Harmon commended Andrew Walker for being selected to the Arkansas High School Basketball All Star Game and performing well in the event on June 23rd at Conway.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Robert Reeves, to adjourn at 8:00 p.m. Motion passed, 6-0.
