The IZard County Consolidated School Board met in regular session on July 12, 2021, in the IZard County High School Cafeteria.

Roll call showed all members present.

Dr. Candace Killian made a motion, seconded by Julia Chapman, to approve a Resolution Authorizing the Issuance of an Installment Contract to Finance Improvements to the District's Track; And Prescribing Other Matters Pertaining To. Motion passed, 6-0.

Robert Reeves made a motion, seconded by Rhonda Moss, to approve the minutes of the June 14, 2021, regular meeting. Motion passed, 7-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Julia Chapman, to approve the financial report. Motion passed, 7-0.

Mike McCandlis and Robert Reeves left the meeting at this time.

Julia Chapman made a motion, seconded by Debbie Moody, to continue to do business with Reeves Propane, Inc., Robert Reeves has a financial interest in the business) and Knockout, Inc. (Board member Mike McCandlis is the owner) because they are located in the school district and offer competitive prices. Motion passed, 5-0.

Robert Reeves returned to the meeting at this time.

Dr. Candace Killian made a motion, seconded by Julia Chapman, to move \$650,000 from operating fund to building fund. Motion passed, 7-0.

Elementary Principal Eve Hatman announced that the district provided two STEM Academic camps this summer for over 80 K-8 students with lunch and bus transportation provided by the district. Assistant Principal David Harmon announced the Cougar Golf Tournament raised over \$10,000 for the Athletic Department.
