The IZard County Consolidated School Board met in regular session on June 12, 2019, in the IZard County High School Board Room.

Roll call showed Debbie Moody absent.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Candace Killian, to approve the minutes of the May 15, 2019, regular meeting. Motion passed, 6-0.

Candace Killian made a motion, seconded by Rhonda Moss, to approve the financial report. Motion passed, 6-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Rhonda Moss, to elect Julia Chapman, President; Mike McCandlis, Vice-President; and Danny Blankenship, Secretary for the next year. Motion passed, 6-0. Superintendent Fred Walker commended Candace Killian for serving as president for the past year.

Rhonda Moss made a motion, seconded by Robert Reeves, to accept the resignation of Preschool Aide Tina Thomas. Motion passed, 6-0.

Robert Reeves made a motion, seconded by Candace Killian, to approve the employment of Ginger Miller as art teacher for the 2019-20 school year. Motion passed, 6-0.

Robert Reeves made a motion, seconded by Mike McCandlis, to approve the 2019-20 licensed and classified salary schedules. Motion passed, 6-0. Walker noted that the licensed salary schedule was increased on each step by \$1,000 and the classified salary schedule was increased proportionally to the licensed salary schedule. The state will send the district \$50,239.80 this coming school year as a licensed salary supplement. This increases the base bachelor's degree teacher's salary to \$34,500 and the top master's degree teacher's salary to \$49,550 for the 2019-20 school year.

Principal Billy McBride said that the high school had just completed its annual summer ACT Prep class and 15 ICC students participated this year along with four ICC teachers. McBride noted that this program is free to all ICC students in grades 9-12 and the school pays for the ACT test for all students who complete the program. McBride said that this program has been a great service to the ICC students over the years to raise their ACT scores by several points. He told the board that the school also provides a fall ACT Prep class and ACT test for ICC students free. ICC is the only area school that provides this free service twice a year to its students.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Candace Killian, to adjourn at 8:50 p.m. Motion passed, 6-0.
