The IZard County Consolidated School Board met in regular session on June 22, 2022, in the IZard County High School Cafeteria.

Roll call showed Rhonda Moss absent.

Dr. Candace Killian made a motion, seconded by Danny Blankenship, to approve the minutes of the May 19, 2022, regular meeting. Motion passed, 6-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Julia Chapman, to approve the financial report. Motion passed, 6-0.

Debbie Moody made a motion, seconded by Dr. Candace Killian, to approve the following slate of officers for the next year – President – Danny Blankenship, Vice-President – Robert Reeves, and Secretary - Julia Chapman. Motion passed, 6-0.
