The Izard County Consolidated School Board met in regular session on November 13, 2014 in the Izard County High School Board Room.

Roll call showed all members present.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded Julia Chapman, to approve the minutes of the October 13, 2014 regular meeting. Motion passed, 7-0.

Julia Chapman made a motion, seconded by Rhonda Moss, to approve the financial report. Motion passed, 7-0.

Danny Blankenship made a motion, seconded by Kenny Morehead, to accept the resignation of Elementary Cook Rhonda Faigle, effective October 17, 2014. Motion passed, 7-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Debbie Moody, to employ Linda Ball as elementary cook for the remainder of the 2014-15 school year. Motion passed, 7-0.

Superintendent Fred Walker announced that seven students had been selected All-Region Choir this year. The students are seniors April McCoy, Aricaa Charbauski, Amber Cowan, and Lucan Smith, eighth graders Colten Hypes and Abby White, and seventh grader Katrina Smith. Lucas made first chair in the region and he will be auditioning for the Arkansas All State Choir in February. Chelsea Phillips is the Choir Director.

Walker told the board that the recent Elementary Fall Festival had raised over \$5,000 for the elementary school activity fund.

Middle School Principal Billy McBride told the board that the recent state accreditation monitoring had gone well with only one minor handbook change noted by the state review team. McBride praised this staff for their hard work and this accreditation report is a reflection of the job they are all doing educating our students. McBride noted that ICC has never been cited for any probationary accreditation citation in the history of the district.

McBride also noted that the District Hoop Shoot would be held December 6 at Highland.

Elementary Principal John Walker announced that the Elementary Christmas Music Program was scheduled for December 8 and the High School and Middle School Christmas Program will be December 15.

Board Member Debbie Moody presented 1 \$100 donation to the district on behalf of the IZARD County Master Gardeners in appreciation for the district's help in coordinating the recent successful IZARD County Master Gardeners Convention held at the high school. Superintendent Fred Walker noted that Events Coordinator Tim Massey helped coordinate the event.

Debbie Moody made a motion, seconded by Kenny Morehead, to approve the transfer request to Salem. Motion passed, 7-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Danny Blankenship, to adjourn at 7:53 p.m. Motion passed, 7-0.
