The IZard County Consolidated School Board met in regular session on October 14, 2019, in the IZard County High School Board Room.

Roll call showed Danny Blankenship, Candace Killian, and Rhonda Moss absent.

Debbie Moody made a motion, seconded by Mike McCandlis, to approve the minutes of the October 14, 2019, regular meeting. Motion passed, 4-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Robert Reeves, to approve the financial report. Motion passed, 4-0.

Julia Chapman made a motion, seconded by Debbie Moody, to approve the 5% Resolution. Motion passed, 4-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Robert Reeves, to approve school transfers. Motion passed, 4-0.

Debbie Moody made a motion, seconded by Julia Chapman, to employ Paige Simpson as needed for the 2019-20 school year as a kindergarten paraprofessional. Motion passed, 4-0.

Superintendent Fred Walker told the board that the annual chili supper during the Black and Gray basketball games raised \$4,400 for the Kailey Moss Scholarship Fund.

Principal Billy McBride told the board that the band program had recently purchased an additional \$15,000 in band instruments as part of the district's annual commitment to the band program. McBride commended band director Jonathan Phillips and the students for our outstanding program and noted that this year 72 students are participating in band in grades 5-12. McBride also commended the junior high volleyball team for finishing second in the conference with an 11-1 record. Mr. McBride also announced that the school's Esports team will begin its season soon with 16 students participating in Rocket League, SMITE, and League of Legends competitions through the Arkansas Activities Association. McBride also praised the quiz bowl team and coach Charles Treat for sponsoring a well-run 13 team invitational quiz bowl tournament recently at the high school.

Assistant Principal David Harmon announced that at the State Fair and Livestock Show, Payten Hutchins won Grand Champion Yearling Ewe, Tess Savell won Reserve Grand Champion Jr. Santa Gertrudis Heifer, and Zeb Felton won second in class with his Angus Bull. Harmon also

announced that at the District Fair, Jacee Morehead, Addysyn Kinion, and Ryan Morehead swept the Dairy Cattle Showmanship awards and in the Horse Show, Gracie Crider, Heath Morehead, and Jacee Morehead also swept the Showmanship awards. Gracie also won Reserve Grand Champion Jr. Pony, Grand Champion Open Pony, Reserve Grand Champion Jr. Mare, and Reserve Grand Champion Open Gelding. Keylon and Landon Gross won Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Gilts in their breed in the Hog Show. In the Beef Cattle Show, there were several class winners from ICC. Harmon congratulated the golf team for placing fourth in the state and second in the district with Landon McBride finishing fourth overall and was named all state. Harmon also told the board that the new C & C Plasma Cutting Table had been received by the agri department.

Elementary Principal Eve Hatman told the board that the Fall Festival was set for November 7 from 5pm-7pm with the Chili Supper and Bingo starting at 4:30.
