The IZARD County Consolidated School Board met in regular session on October 19, 2016, in the IZARD County High School Board Room.

Roll call showed all members present.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Candace Killian, to approve the following slate of officers for the 2016-17 school year: President – Rhonda Moss, Vice-President – Julia Chapman, and Secretary - Candace Killian. Motion passed, 7-0. Superintendent Fred Walker commended out-going President Debbie Moody for serving as President for the past year.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Danny Blankenship, to approve the minutes of the September 12, 2016, regular meeting. Motion passed, 7-0.

Rhonda Moss made a motion, seconded by Candace Killian, to approve the financial report. Motion passed, 7-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Debbie Moody, to approve the Act 1120 5% Salary Increases Report. Motion passed, 7-0.

Walker announced that State Representatives Michelle Gray and James Sturch had recently visited the middle and high school campuses and toured the Biomedical Sciences Program, the Animal Science Barn and Artificial Insemination Lab, the Alternative Learning Environment Classroom, and the Computer Science Initiative Program. He said Rep. Gray and Rep. Sturch told him they were very impressed with the many opportunities that the ICC district afforded its students above state requirements. Walker also told the board that IZARD County Judge David Sherrell had been very helpful to the district by promptly grading roads as needed and providing gravel and other services to the district and he wanted to commend him for all his help while he has been in office.

Walker also said that over \$1,500 was raised at the recent Kailey Moss Memorial Scholarship Chili Supper and that \$16,000 in scholarships have been distributed to ICC seniors since 2010 from the Moss Memorial Scholarship Fund. Middle School Principal Billy McBride told the board that Parent-Teacher Conferences would be held October 27th from 2-6 p.m. and the Fall Festival at the elementary campus would be held November 3. McBride noted that the grades 1-6 Intramural Basketball Program had been completed with six nights of basketball games and over 120 students participating in the program. High School Principal David Harmon announced that the Boys Golf Team had finished State Runner-up for the second consecutive year and also were district champions. Cody Workman was district medalist runner-up and Cody Workman, Matthew Workman, and Tyler Pemberton were named All State. On the girls' side, Mikayla Kish

was the individual state champion and was also district medalist. Kish was also named All State. Elementary Principal Eve Hatman announced that the district now has Chromebooks available for all students from grades 1-12 and Chromebook labs are available for all kindergarten students.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Julia Chapman, to adjourn at 8:35 p.m. Motion passed, 7-0.
