The IZARD County Consolidated School Board met in regular session on September 10, 2018, in the IZARD County High School Board Room.

Roll call showed Rhonda Moss absent.

School Administrators presented the Annual Report to the Public.

Robert Reeves made a motion, seconded by Danny Blankenship, to approve the minutes of the August 20, 2018, regular meeting. Motion passed, 6-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Candace Killian, to approve the financial report. Motion passed, 6-0.

Superintendent Fred Walker announced that beginning September 10th that the IZARD County Sheriff's Office would provide a sheriff's deputy at the IZARD County Elementary School at Violet Hill on an everyday basis for the entire school year. Walker said he met with IZARD County Chief Deputy Earnie Blackley and IZARD County Sheriff Jack Yancey and they worked out a purchased service agreement between the school district and the sheriff's office last week. Walker said, "This gives the IZARD County Consolidated School District a police officer stationed at both the Violet Hill and Brockwell campuses every day to help provide a safe and secure environment for all the district's students and staff." Walker said the district already had a full-time school resource officer stationed at the Brockwell campus.

Walker also told the board that district enrollment presently was at 507 which is up from last year.

Principal Billy McBride said that the intramural basketball program had started and there were over 110 participants in grades 1-6. McBride also noted that the high school had four students enrolled in the welding program provided by Ozarka College and that the high school had added a beef science course to the high school curriculum.

Debbie Moody made a motion, seconded by Candace Killian, to accept the resignation of Preschool Aide Kelly Shelton, effective immediately. Motion passed, 6-0.

Debbie Moody made a motion, seconded by Mike McCandlis, to adjourn at 7:50 p.m. Motion passed, 6-0.
