The IZARD County Consolidated School Board met in regular session on March 28, 2018, in the IZARD County High School Board Room.

Roll call showed all members present.

Debbie Moody made a motion, seconded by Rhonda Moss, to approve the minutes of the January 10, 2018, regular meeting. Motion passed, 7-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Candace Killian, to approve the financial report. Motion passed, 7-0.

Danny Blankenship made a motion, seconded by Julia Chapman, to accept the resignation of Special Education Paraprofessional Vonda Crider, effective January 26, 2018. Motion passed, 7-0.

Julia Chapman made a motion, seconded by Danny Blankenship, to employ April Glass as a Special Education Paraprofessional, retroactive to January 29, 2018. Motion passed, 7-0.

Rhonda Moss made a motion, seconded by Candace Killian to extend the contracts of Billy McBride as Grades 5-12 Principal and Eve Hatman as Elementary Principal by one year through June 30, 2020 and to employ David Harmon on a 210 day contract as Assistant High School Principal, Girls Head Basketball Coach, and Golf Coach and extend his contract through June 30, 2020. Motion passed, 7-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Candace Killian, to re-employ all teachers for the 2017-18 school year who wished to return. Motion passed, 7-0.

High School Principal David Harmon announced that Justus Cooper and Caleb Faulkner were named All State and All State Tournament in basketball recently. He commended the senior boys team for winning conference, district and finishing state runner-up. Justus, Caleb, Dylan Tharp, and Mike Uecker were named all conference in senior boys, Laney Rider and Harley Thomason in senior girls, and Coby Everett, Chase Orf, Noah Everett, Gunner Gleghorn, and Rifle Comstock in junior boys. Harmon also commended the Shooting Sports Team for winning the Salem Outdoor Expo trap shoot (Hayden Ekenes, Seth McCurley, Zach Williams, Hayden Lewis, Drew Foster). Harmon also announced that the EAST kids did great at their state conference and the students won an award for competing in some engineering challenges while there.

Harmon also announced that the sr. high quiz bowl had placed 2nd in Regionals on March 10 and that Benji Norton was named an All Star.

Middle School Principal Billy McBride announced that the IZARD County Elementary Chess Teams won the elementary division in the Northcentral Educational coop tournament. Xander McCandlis finished first and Jacob Stone finished 3rd. McBride commended the Jr. high Quiz Bowl Team for finishing 4th in the state.
