The Izard County Consolidated School Board met in regular session on May 21, 2018, in the Izard County High School Board Room.

Roll call showed Julia Chapman absent.

Rhonda Moss made a motion, seconded by Debbie Moody, to approve the minutes of the April 23, 2018, regular meeting. Motion passed, 5-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Candace Killian, to approve the financial report. Motion passed, 5-0.

Robert Reeves made a motion, seconded by Mike McCandlis, to accept the resignation of High School English Teacher Elizabeth Cowan. Motion passed, 5-0. She is moving out of state.

Debbie Moody made a motion, seconded by Candace Killian, to employ Teresa Jones as Art / Dyslexia Teacher and move Art/Dyslexia Teacher Courtney Sanders to Middle School Teacher and move Middle School Teacher Maggie Campbell to High School English Teacher. Motion passed, 5-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Rhonda Moss, to approve the 2018-19 School calendar. Motion passed, 5-0.

Candace Killian made a motion, seconded by Debbie Moody to accept six school Choice students into the district, three from Salem and three from Melbourne. Motion passed, 5-0.

Debbie Moody made a motion, seconded by Mike McCandlis, to appoint Danny Blankenship to the school board until the next election. Motion passed, 5-0.

Candace Killian made a motion, seconded by Debbie Moody, to approve two school choice applications into the district from Melbourne. Motion passed, 5-0.

High School Principal David Harmon announced that Hayden Lewis had won second in the state in FFA Creed Speaking and that the team of Hayden Ekenes, Seth McCurley, Dillon Lyons, Zach Williams, and Drew Foster had placed second in the state in a shooting sports competition.

Harmon also announced that Kyle McCandlis was named Arkansas Democrat-Gazette Three Rivers Edition Coach of the Year, Justus Cooper was Player of the Year, and Caleb Faulkner was a member of the Three Rivers Edition Team for the senior boys.
