The IZARD County Consolidated School Board met in regular session on November 9, 2015, in the IZARD County High School Board Room.

Roll call showed Robert Reeves absent.

Rhonda Moss made a motion, seconded by Danny Blankenship, to approve the minutes of the October 12, 2015, regular meeting. Motion passed, 6-0.

Mike McCandlis made a motion, seconded by Rhonda Moss, to approve the financial report. Motion passed, 6-0.

Walker also noted that the IZARD County Master Gardeners had made a \$100 donation to the school district for hosting the IZARD County Master Gardener's Convention again this year.

High School Principal David Harmon announced that Andrew Walker was named as a state finalist for the Wendy's Heisman Award. Harmon also announced that Abby Van

Cleave and Katrina Smith were named junior high All Region Choir and Autumn Thick, Nancy Mkaabal, and Benji Norton were named senior high All Region Choir.

Middle School Principal Billy McBride announced that the junior high quiz bowl team had competed well in a quiz bowl invitational tournament at Greene County Tech recently. McBride also commended Middle School Teacher Maggie Campbell for her presentation of “Fluency Practices in the Classroom” at the Arkansas Curriculum Conference in Little Rock recently.
